

Tamika L. Law is an accomplished singer, performer, actor and business woman who has mastered the art of combining her Administrative gifts with her lifelong passion of music. She is a highly motivated, and goal driven entrepreneur whose strong work ethic and love for music and people has propelled her into her God given destiny.

Born and raised in Dayton, Ohio Tamika has been singing since the age of five. Singing all through elementary, high school and college she got her first big break singing in a gospel stage play "Tell Hell I Ain't Coming" in 2003 starring Ollie "Ali" Woodson of the Temptations, Gary "Lil G" Jenkins from Silk and R&B singer Monifah. She toured briefly with the play to audiences in the Midwest before moving to the DC area in 2004. She quickly made a name for herself singing in many bands as lead vocalist, growing to band leader and eventually formed her own band and music company in 2009, Musically Yours Entertainment Group, Inc.

As the founder of Musically Yours Entertainment Group, which specializes in booking live music entertainment for events of all types and providing a unique experience that caters to each client's specific needs, Tamika has found her niche in bringing to life the musical vision of each client and personally creating the soundtrack to their special day. Musically Yours also offers voice lessons, stage performance, and artist development. Another arm of Musically Yours includes a rehearsal space for singers/performers/musicians/artists where they can come rehearse practice and hone their skills in an environment that promotes and fosters musical excellence through preparation, repetition, practice and performance.

In 2009 Tamika auditioned and was one of 3 singers selected out of about 300 to become a member of the now multi-Stellar Award winning, two-time Dove Award winning, and Grammy nominated gospel group Anthony Brown and Group Therapy with whom she was a member for 8 years where she had the privilege of traveling all over the country singing and ministering the word of God. She has been seen performing on BET's Celebration of Gospel, BET's Sundays Best, the Stellar Awards, the Dove Awards as well as multiple seasons on BET's Bobby Jones Gospel.

In 2013, Tamika also displayed her management abilities and knowledge of the industry as business manager for GKAM Records, a local record label managing their day-today affairs and all artists on the roster. As an artist herself on the label, she flexed her muscles as Executive Producer on the holiday CD, A GKAM Christmas for the label as well as coordinated a successful CD release for the label's jazz artist at the legendary jazz club Blues Alley where she was featured on a hit single "One For Me". Tamika has also performed at the famed Howard Theatre, Bethesda Blues & Jazz and the Carlyle Club to name a few.

In 2019, Tamika launched a concert series the New Artist Showcase in partnership with Alice's Jazz & Cultural Society in Washington, DC. This endeavor has produced some amazing new artists and exposure for Musically Yours as a beacon of light and encouragement in the music community at large helping young or inexperienced artists hone their craft and build their fan base while getting opportunities to perform.

A proud and active member of the First Baptist Church of Glenarden, Tamika ministered faithfully each Sunday in the Music and Arts Department, as a member of the Praise & Worship Team for about 10 years and was also cast in 2010 as Mary in the church's inaugural musical production of "The Uncut Coming of Christ" written by Joshua Jenkins and music by Anthony Brown. She sang the lead role and performed with Kim Burrell as the Angel along with Terrance Shingler as Joseph. She set the precedent for what has now become a coveted role that national recording artists have been cast for the past 11 years.

Tamika is now focused on expanding her company, increasing revenue and partnering with other music entities, to promote musical excellence, unity and mentorship in the arts and grooming and nurturing the amazing gifts of her daughter Jaali as the next star performer of Musically Yours Entertainment.
